- **Google Apps**- An online suite of productivity and digital tools.
- **Voki**- a talking avatar creator that can be used to share their ideas.
- **Voicethread**- website that allows students to communicate and to make comments on other projects using any mix of text, a microphone, a web cam, or uploaded audio file.
- **Glogster**- a social network that allows users to create free interactive posters, or Glogs
- **Weebly**- an easy way to create a high- quality websites.
- **Go Animate**- an animated video creator that allows users to creator a digital stories or presentations.
- **Prezi** - a cloud-based presentation software and storytelling tool for presenting ideas on a virtual canvas

Your child's safety and security are our number one priority. All websites and tools have been and will continue to be thoroughly examined and are used commonly in education today.

Students will follow school policies for appropriate use when using Internet based services like Web 2.0 applications & Google Apps. These services are considered an extension of the school's network.
